Any style that is a bit eye catching, stripey or themed would be wonderful as they are very attractive souvenirs for people visiting in-store and they raise vital funds for the not-for-profit Penguin Foundation. As the jumpers are not for use on animals, the need for pure wool is gone – acrylic is fine and the requirements for no buttons and embellishments is no more and we invite you to have some fun! Buttons, bow ties and bling are all encouraged!
